ROYAL BAYOU, wide leaving the backstretch, circled the turn, bumped with SHORTY JAWNSON near the three sixteenths pole and weakened. SHORTY JAWNSON, two wide, chased the pace, bumped with ROYAL BAYOU in upper stretch and weakened. OUR CHIEFTAN, no factor, was three wide turning for home. SOL T DAWG, rank leaving the starting gate, was four wide on the turn, swung to the six path entering the stretch and was outrun. HEMBY THREE hugged the rail and was outrun.
